1. What is the Spiritual Exercises in Daily Life – Itinerary 5, 19th Annotation program?

The Spiritual Exercises, through God's grace, provides a guide, the scripture, prayer and instruction to deepen our relationship with God. This program enables a participant to have the full experience of the Ignatian Spiritual Exercises in a 9-month format instead of 30-day silent retreat. It is an adaption of St. Ignatius' Spiritual Exercises according to the 19th note (hence the name 19th Annotation Spiritual Exercises). You will be guided through the program by a Prayer Companion and be connected to others through faith sharing and instruction.

2. How long is this program?

The program lasts at least 9 months, starting in September 2025 and ending at the end of May 2026 or longer depending on the retreatant's situation.

3. What are the requirements for participation?

- Daily Commitment to daily prayer (45 min. to one hour)
- Weekly Meeting one-on-one with the assigned Prayer Companion (30 min. to one hour)
- Monthly Attend instructional session on Ignatian Spirituality and small group sharing (2 hours)

4. How are the small groups formed?

A small group consists of 6 to 8 retreatants plus their assigned Prayer Companions. The groups will be formed based on language and time zone. Meeting dates & times are to be set by each small group with the help of the Group Leader.

5. What happens in the monthly small group sharing session?

Participants are given the opportunity to share their prayer experience (graces and challenges) received from their individual prayer over the last month. The purpose of sharing in small groups is for the retreatants to support each other throughout the 19th Annotation journey.

6. Last day to register and who will accompany the retreatant throughout the program? Each retreatant will complete the registration form on the LTTCS website (https://www.lttcs.net). The due date for submitting the registration form is July 31st, 2025. Based on the information provided, the participant will be paired with a Prayer Companion who will accompany the participant from start to the end of the 19th Annotation program.

8. How much is the total cost?

The fee for the program is US \$300.00 which is due on July 31st, 2025. The fee is non-refundable if you do not complete the retreat. This fee covers liability insurance for the Prayer Companion, donation to the Ignatian Spirituality Center of Salamanca, Zoom service, and any other necessary expenses.
